- The purpose is to update the 2019 plan to meet state (IEMA) & federal (FEMA) requirements.
- This time, the process will be split into separate plans:
  - WSP Peoria, for flood expertise, and
  - AEC Tazewell and Woodford Counties.
- The grant is funded by 85% Federal/15% local match .
- This group will meet four times .
- Mitigation: things we can do in our jurisdiction to minimize hazards.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Sustained action to reduce long-term risk to people and property.
- Mitigation Advisory Committee goal: assess vulnerabilities in the system to address them.
  - Activities and projects are eligible.
- Multi-hazard mitigation plan:
  - Both natural and manmade hazards. Each hazard will be a section of the plans.
  - Can use historical data to inform future hazards.
- Main reason for update is to access federal mitigation funds:
  - $\circ$   $\;$  New jurisdictions are eligible to join each 5-year cycle.
  - Damages (\$) have risen considerably over the past few years.
    - 2022 was an expensive year: \$162.1 billion (national).
    - Local: Tazewell and Woodford rain and flash flooding.
  - Must be participant in the active plan.
  - Allows the community to focus on projects they specifically need.
- Requirements to be an active participant:
  - 1. Participate in committee meetings,
  - 2. Complete the required forms,
  - 3. Coordinate with constituents and the public, and
  - 4. Adopt the plan once it is complete (resolution).
  - Meetings: 4 total including public forum.
- Handouts return by next meeting (paper or digital):
  - Compatibility assessments,
  - Critical facilities survey,
  - Shelter survey, and
  - Drinking water supply worksheet.
- Community participation is important.
