4. Approval of Minutes, May 15, 2024, Meeting

5. Public Meeting: FY 2025-28 Transportation Improvement Program

Rich Brecklin moved to open the Public Meeting: FY 2025-28 Transportation Improvement Program and Jeff Gilles seconded. Motion carried.

Michael Bruner updated on the following:

- The TIP is currently in the 30-day comment period.
- This plan is annually updated and includes projects that are federally funded or regionally significant that are set for bid letting during FY25-28.
- Last month, TCRPC presented a draft list of projects that would be included in the TIP.
- Since last month, the only changes to the draft list were the addition of Peoria County's TIP amendment and the City of Washington's Safe Routes to School Award.
- During the comment period, TCRPC is taking edits to the list. The comment period ends July 25, 2024.
- After the comment period, the TIP will be sent to the Commission at their August 7th meeting for adoption.

Paola Mendez moved to close the public meeting, and Jeff Gilles seconded. Motion carried.

6. Overview of FY 2025 Special Transportation Studies Requests

Michael Bruner presented on the following:

- This year, TCRPC received four applications for its FY 25 Special Transportation Studies Call for Projects.
- The total request submitted to staff was \$255,000, but Tri-County has programmed \$181,000 for special transportation planning projects.
- The Village of Bartonville applied to develop an Active Transportation Plan
- The City of East Peoria seeks funding to complete its inventory of stormwater, runoffs, outfalls, pipes, and inlets.
- The City of Peoria is seeking funding to update their 2016 Bicycle Master Plan.
- The Village of Peoria Heights applied to develop a parking study in their central business district.

7. Formation of Special Transportation Studies Project Review Committee

Michael Bruner asked the Technical Committee for three volunteers to assist in the review process for the FY 25 Special Transportation Studies Requests. After deliberation, the committee members that were selected to participate on the review committee are Amy McLaren, Kinga Krider, and Jon Oliphant.

- Charging Infrastructure Grant:
 - The City of Peoria is reapplying for the grant that they did not originally receive funding for.
 - TCRPC is hoping to submit a smaller application for the entities that were left out of the city's application.
 - The two applications being submitted are not competing for the same pool of funds.

Michael noted that the Combined Call for Projects is due at the end of the week, on June 28 at 3:30 p.m.
