Open House Stations and Activities



- Idea Cards
 - *Participants are given an index card and asked to share their idea to conserve the Peoria Lakes*
 - *Participants are given an opportunity to share and expand on their ideas if not already covered by the USACE.*

- Individual boards for each Conservation Alternative
 - *Participants will be prompted to share what they like the most and least about each alternative.*
 - *Participants will also be allowed to share general comments for each conservation alternative*

Open House Stations and Activities, Cont.

- “Parking Lot” Station 
 - *This station would list the Project Elements that were not considered in the Alternatives.*
 - *Participants would be allowed to add to the list with their ideas from the Idea Card activity*
 - *Participants would prioritize the Project Elements*
 - Based off the same method PRC members will prioritize the Conservation Alternatives
 - Will be explained further under Prioritization Tool and Criteria

Open House Stations and Activities, Cont.

- Conservation Alternative Prioritization Station
 - *This station would list the Conservation Alternatives and allow participants to use sticky dots to vote for the alternatives based off a set of criteria.*
 - *Participants would prioritize the Conservation Alternatives*
 - Based off the same method PRC members will use
 - Will be explained further under Prioritization Tool and Criteria
- Prioritization Criteria Feedback
 - *This station will ask participants to supply thoughts and recommendation on the criteria used during the prioritization of both the Conservation Alternatives and the “Parking Lot”*



Open House Stations and Activities, Cont.

- Stakeholder Survey

- *Allow participants to take the stakeholder survey during the Open House*
- *This survey will be developed next month*



Prioritization Tool and Criteria



- Simplify to tool for easy explanation and use
- Limit the number of criteria
 - *Environmental Impact*
 - Possible beneficial effects caused by the implementation of a conservation alternative. These effects can be direct and indirect benefits.
 - *Regional Impact*
 - Increase the Tri-County quality of life, such as increasing lakefront access, recreational opportunities, or spurring economic development.
 - Have a substantial effect upon the health, safety, or welfare of citizens of Tri-County.
 - *Feasibility*
 - Capable of being successfully completed in a sustainable manner
 - Able to be maintained at a reasonable level

Prioritization Tool and Criteria



- Simplify
 - *Sticky Dot voting*
 - *Three colors of sticky dots*
 - Environmental Impact ●
 - Regional Impact ●
 - Feasibility ●
