- 5. Recommend to Commission Resolution 22-55 Joint Funding Agreement FY 2023 Attachment Amy McClaren moved to recommend to Commission Resolution 22-55 Joint Funding Agreement FY 2023 and Rick Semonski seconded.
 Michael Bruner explained these are match funds that Tri County asks for on an annual basis. We are using State Metropolitan Planning Funds for the MPO match. These dollars will either be used for additional/local projects or refunded to the member agencies per Commission approval. If you plan to use MFT funds to match, please let us know so we understand if there are any conditional requirements on these dollars.

 - a. Project S-23-06 Intersection Improvements
 Michael Bruner explained this is for installation of traffic signals at IL Route 9 (Veterans)
 and 14th Street in Pekin. This amendment is to add this project to the FY23 program.
 - b. Project S-23-07 Bridge Replacements
 Michael Bruner explained is for I-474 bridge replacement over IL Route 116 (Plank Road) in Bellevue. This amendment is to add this project to the FY23 program.

- 7. Discussion of Draft FY 2023-26 TIP Handout
 - a. Discussion of including an Illustrative (Future) Project Database in the TIP
 - Michael Bruner discussed that this is a rough draft of the FY23-26 TIP. He asked to please review the program and let him know if there are any additions or edits with projects for your jurisdiction. He noted he still has not heard back from everyone regarding the March 22nd email and several reminders. He will need this by end of business day next Wednesday, May 25th. The surface Transportation project listing starts on page 10 and the Mass Transit project listing starts on Page 13. Please note this does not include any new IDOT

- projects as we are waiting for the release of the MYP. These projects will be amended in the TIP after the fact.
- The proposed Project timeline is Public Comments period- month of June. There
 will be 3 Public Hearings- Commission- June 1, Technical Committee- June 15
 and Executive Board- June 20 the adoption will be July 6, 2022, Commission
 meeting.
- Illustrative Project Narrative has been added to the rough draft document using track changes.
- Executive Summary included updated language in page IV
- The amendment process has been updated on page 4. To move a project for the Illustrative List to the TIP requires Commission approval. Adding to or editing Illustrative Projects can be done by staff via Administration Modification.
- Illustrative Project Listing Section starts on page 1 with a narrative:
 - Summary of Definition of what an illustrative the Federal Transportation
 Bill authorization to include Illustrative projects in the TIP
 - Definition of what an illustrative project is
 - Requirements to be considered as illustrative
 - The amendment process and the numbering process
- The Illustrative Project Listing starts on page 16.
- Additionally, staff is developing an online GIS database that will be available with an online version of the TIP.
