Action needed by Technical Committee:

Approve slate of officers for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023:

• Chair: Craig Fink, Tazewell County

• Vice-Chair: Kinga Krider, City of West Peoria

Background:

The bylaws of the PPUATS Technical Committee state that a Chair and Vice-Chair shall be elected from the representatives in good standing for two-year terms. The most recent slate of officers was elected for Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021, with terms expiring June 30, 2021. Therefore, PPUATS Technical requires new officers to carry out regular business effectively.

The Nominations Committee recommends Craig Fink for Chair and Kinga Krider for Vice-Chair, both to serve two-year terms. Both members have indicated their willingness to serve PPUATS Technical as officers and accept the Nominations Committee's recommendation.
