- 3. Public Comment-none
- Approval of Minutes, July 20, 2022, Meeting
   Terry Keogel moved to approve Minutes of July 20, 2022, and Rich Brecklin seconded. Motion carried.
- Recommend to Commission Special Transportation Studies Projects Handout
   Conrad Moore moved to recommend to Commission Special Transportation Studies Projects and
   Amy McLaren seconded.

Reema Abi-Akar updated on the following:

- Tri County released a call for projects on June 15, 2022. The total funding amount is \$123,000. The applications were due on July 15, 2022. The staff received 3 applications plus two TDM requests.
  - Chillicothe requested \$30,000 for a Trail Master Plan & ITEP application assistance
  - Pekin requested \$60,000 with a \$10,000 local match for a Master Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.
  - Peoria requested \$28,000 with \$7,000 local match for an Intersection Safety
     Study at Sterling Avenue and Forrest Hill
  - TDM request to assist with Transportation Management Plans
    - Allen Road from War Memorial Drive to Northmoor Road
    - Old Galena Road from Illinois Route 29 to State-Old Galena Road Roundabout
- Special Studies Review Subcommittee met on August 16 to review and score each application (Rich Brecklin, Conrad Moore, and Jon Oliphant)
  - Pekin- score 85.0
  - o Peoria- score 77.5
  - o TDM request- score 68.75
  - Chillicothe- score 52.5
- Additional funding was able to find an additional \$8,044 to incorporate in the available pot, making \$131,044 in available funding.
- Subcommittee recommended
  - Pekin at \$60,000 for Master Bike/Ped Plan
  - Peoria at \$28,000 for Intersection Study
  - TCRPC at \$22,830 for TDM Requests
  - Partially funded- Chillicothe at \$20,214 for Trail Plan Funding was reduced due to a portion of the funding was proposed to assist in an ITEP application; however, in this case the timing will not work with a due date of Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> and procurement process would be necessary to select a consultant.

Amy McLaren asked if Chillicothe had any concerns on the results and Eric Miller said they were ok with it.

- 6. Call for Projects STBG Preservation Set-Aside Attachment Michael Bruner reported on the following:
  - a. STBG Preservation Set- Aside
    - \$1.64M will be available for resurfacing projects
      - 1. 20% local match required
      - 2. Due: September 30th by 4:00 PM
      - 3. Match resolutions due to state of October 19
      - 4. October 19th project presentation
  - b. Instructions and the applications can be found on our website and were emailed to you this morning.
  - c. The City of Pekin and City of Peoria are not eligible to receive preservation funding due to receiving funding from the traditional program.

#### 7. Updates

- a. Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant
  - The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) established the new Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary program
  - Included \$5 billion in appropriated funds over the next 5 years.
    - Supports the
      - National Roadway Safety Strategy and
      - USDOT's goal of zero deaths and serious injuries on our nation's roadways.
    - Eligible activities within the SS4A grant program include
      - Developing or updating a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP)
      - Conducting supplement planning activities for a CSAP, or
      - Implementing projects identified in a CSAP
      - To be eligible for an implementation grant, jurisdictions must have a CSAP
      - The grant program is 80/20
      - Applications are due on September 15, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. CST
    - Staff Proposal
      - Apply for their region to have a consultant develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan
      - Local match would either come from participating jurisdictions or membership dues.
        - Staff is exploring local match options, such as receiving funding from each county.
      - IDOT is exploring potentially uses of leftover State MPO funding

In an effort of avoiding delaying the project, we would like to review the amendment and get an "unofficial" recommendation for the Commission meeting on September 7<sup>th</sup>. The Village of Creve Coeur received Safe Routes to School funding for sidewalk and ADA improvements
  - 1. Along the south side of Groveland Street from Allyn St to Eller Ave., and Eleanor Ct. from Groveland St to Briarwood Ct.

The SRTS funding amount is \$145,600 with a \$36,400 local match.

The amendment is adding the project to the FY 2023 Program.

No objections to forward onto Commission in September for approval.

c. Eric Miller added ITEP deadline is September 30th.

## **Background:**

Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Peoria-Pekin urbanized area. As an MPO, one of the responsibilities is to assemble local governments, transportation authorities, and interested citizens to develop regional transportation policies and plans that reflect the region's future vision.

To develop a regional transportation vision, TCRPC invited stakeholders and the public to a Strategic Transportation Planning Session on Thursday, April 28th, from 5:00 to 7:00 pm at the Scottish Rite Theatre. At the event, the group discussed general transportation needs, priorities, and solutions, followed by a live virtual SWOT Analysis to discuss the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats to the region. Following the April 26th event, TCRPC held a Strategic Transportation Planning Session for its Commissioners on Friday, June 3rd, from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm in Room 420.

Following the two events, staff compiled a Strategic Planning Report with recommendations, and one of the suggestions was a regional transportation project prioritization process. At the August 3rd Full Commission meeting, Chairman Don White and Commissioners Russ Crawford, John Kahl, Mark Luft, Chuck Nagel, Nate Parrot, Mike Phelan, and Patrick Urich convened the Regional Transportation Priority Working Group. Since then, the Working Group has met two times, on August 26th and September 8th, to discuss the prioritization approach and review the projects in the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP 2045), adopted June 3rd, 2020 for the Peoria-Pekin Urbanized Area.

## **Project List:**

The transportation project list originated from LRTP 2045. Staff then filtered the projects by budget to only include those over \$10 million, and staff then cross-referenced the projects with the TIP and the recently released IDOT Multi-Year Program (MYP) to eliminate previously funded projects. This process resulted in a list of 43 projects, which does not include newer priorities, such as the Pioneer Parkway Extension and Prospect Road, as these were introduced after the LRTP was completed. Therefore, staff requests local jurisdictions to review the below list by September 30th and add any new projects or suggest removing old priorities. For IDOT and CityLink, staff will connect with them to gather their input. The Working Group will review all submitted feedback for consideration and inclusion in the prioritization process. Any new projects added to the list, like the Pioneer Parkway Extension, will require an amendment in the LRTP. Please note, regionally significant transit and enhancement projects will be evaluated at lower thresholds, such as the Hanna City Trail or East Peoria Riverfront Trail.
